

New Hampshire Winery Association - Membership Application

Membership: The NHWA has three main categories of membership, these are: I) Licensed Professional, II) Non-Licensed professional, and III) Other: Hobbyist, Students and Non-Profit/educational. A professional member is: 1) any entity that is licensed by the state liquor commission (NHLC) to manufacture and sell products to the NHLC or to the public, or 2) any entity that is an agricultural entity (per NH RSA 21:34-a) and selling them to another entity for use in the manufacture of an alcohol product used in the wine industry. Professional members have voting rights on NHWA business in accordance with the NHWA by-laws. A non-licensed professional member includes early start-ups that are at the beginning process of starting a business and have not obtained license. Others include a) hobbyist, b) students actively enrolled in a program of study in the wine industry, or c) employees of nonprofit/educational institutions that are connected to the wine industry (viticulture/oenology/hospitality). Non-professionals do not have voting rights per the NHWA by-laws. All members, regardless of category of membership, shall abide by the association bylaws, articles of agreements and New Hampshire non-profit laws; and demonstrate a professional and ethical approach with other members. Failure to pay annual dues, when due, will result in loss of membership per NHWA By-laws. Membership annual dues are by category.

- * 2021 Non-Licensed Professional (Early Start-Ups) Membership - **\$50**
- * 2021 Other: Hobbyist, Students, Non-Profit/Educational - **\$00**

Notes: Early Start-Ups, and hobbyist, student members (who do not pay dues) are expected to volunteer to work on NHWA sub-committees. Each professional membership has one vote, and other owners and/or employees are encouraged to attend board meeting and other NHWA events.

Membership Approval: Membership applications will be voted on at the next regularly scheduled board meeting. New members will be notified of voting results and will be invoiced for their memberships dues. Dues will be adjusted based on date of approval:

- First Quarter: \$500/\$50 (professional/non-professional)
- Second Quarter: \$375/\$50 (professional/non-professional)
- Third Quarter: \$250/\$50 (professional/non-professional)
- Fourth Quarter: \$125/\$50 (professional/non-professional)
